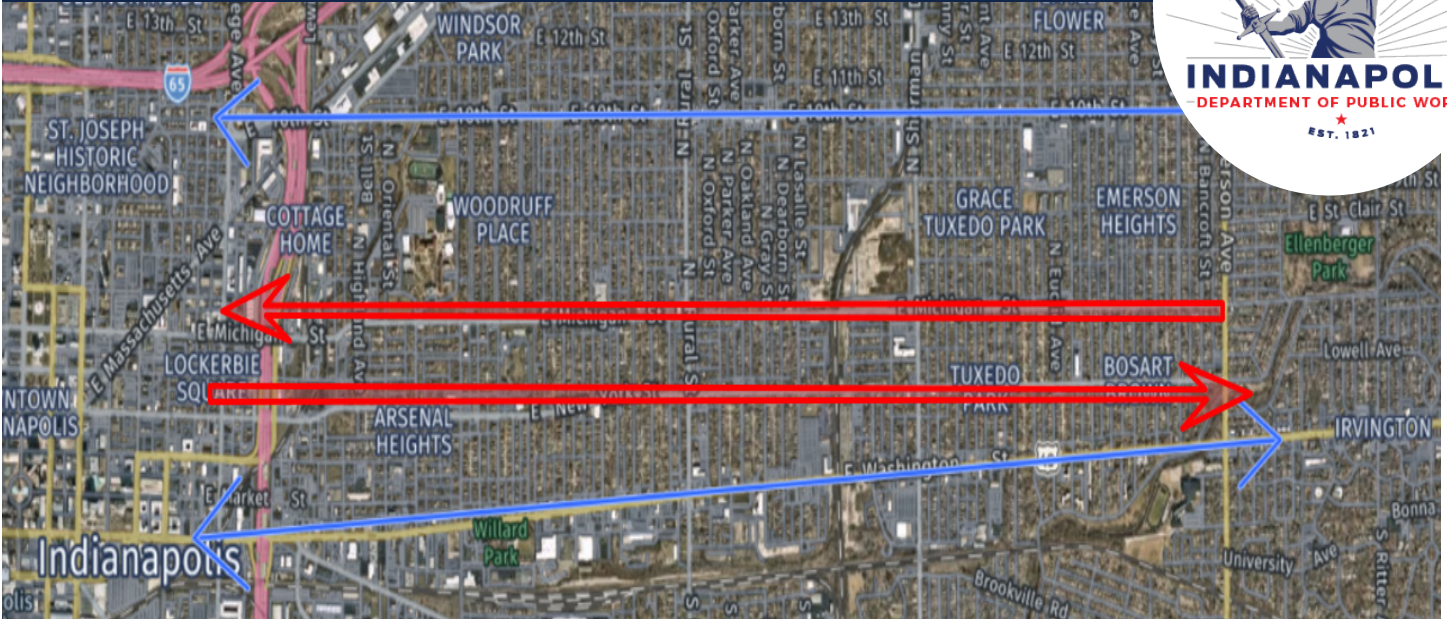


ST-26-054 - MICHIGAN STREET AND NEW YORK STREET TWO WAY CONVERSION



PROJECT DETAILS

This project would convert Michigan Street between College Avenue and Ellenberger Parkway Drive and New York Street between College Avenue to East Pleasant Run Parkway N Drive from one-way traffic to two-way traffic in 2023. Features of the conversion include improvements to existing sidewalks, curbs, crosswalks and ADA ramps, as well as railroad enhancements. Street resurfacing along both Michigan and New York Streets is planned. The upgrades will increase safety and improve community access for residents, commuters, transit riders, pedestrians and bicyclists on Indy's Near Eastside.
