On 12/08/2023 at approximately 0430 hours, I, Officer B. Owens, responded to 1711 W 116th street to assist fire with a male that was unresponsive, breathing, but turning blue.

When I got inside, I was told by an adult male, that I wasn't able to identify, the patient, later identified as James Irsay, had fallen in the bathroom and was moved to his bed. Irsay had oxygen in his nose, was cool to the touch and had agonal breathing. I felt for a pulse which was weak and slow. I gave a sternum rub which had no effect. I immediately began opening my issued Narcan while my partner set up the AED.

I gave Narcan but fire arrived on scene prior to the AED being completed. Irsay was moved to the floor and medics took over. I assisted medics in carrying Irsay from his room outside where we placed him on a cot. He was transported to the hospital via ambulance.

This incident was recorded on my Axon body Worn camera.

On December 8, 2023 at approximately 04:30 AM I, Officer Jacob Harrison, Carmel Fire Department and additional Carmel Police Officers were dispatched to 1711 West 116th Street on an assist medics, medical run. Dispatch advised the complainant, [REDACTED] reported a 64 year old male at the residence was unresponsive with abnormal breathing. [REDACTED] said the male was unconscious and his skin was blue in color.

Officer B. Owens and Officer A. Schoenbein were the first officers on scene. Officers were directed to go to the west gate of the residence. Once there, the complainant, [REDACTED] led officers to an upstairs bedroom inside the residence. Officers located a male, later identified as Jim Irsay [REDACTED] laying in his bed.

Irsay was unconscious with abnormal breathing (agonal breathing), a weak pulse, and he was cold to the touch. Officers attempted to wake him with a sternum rub, but he was unresponsive. Mr. Irsay's pupils were constricted (pinpoint) and his skin had a bluish tint. Officer Owens administered one dosage of Narcan, to which he responded slightly to. Officers were about to attach an AED to Irsay when the Paramedics arrived on scene and took over lifesaving efforts.

I arrived and began gathering medical information and identifying information for Mr. Irsay. [REDACTED] provided a list of medications he is taking [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] advised that she discovered Irsay unresponsive on the bathroom floor. Irsay was moved to his bed by the help of several members of his estate staff several minutes prior to officers and medics arrival at the residence. Medics provided care and transported him to the hospital via ambulance.

At this time, it is unknown what Mr. Irsay had ingested prior to our arrival.

My actions were video, and audio recorded on my Axon Body Camera. Due to the volume of prescribed medications, I uploaded the list of medications for Mr. Irsay to evidence.com.
